

Pine Burr Golf Course Guest Tournament Guidelines

Revised July 2013

Fees

- \$25 per player
- \$100 deposit required to hold the tournament date. If the tournament is cancelled less than one week before the scheduled date, the deposit will not be refunded.
- \$1 will be added to the cost per player fee if you wish to provide range balls
- Food can be provided by The Burr for an additional charge. Cost per player is negotiable.

All fees owed to Pine Burr are due the day of the tournament.

No food or beverages can be sold to tournament players.

The person/organization holding the tournament is responsible for any damage to golf carts used in the tournament as well as any other damage to Pine Burr property. Golf carts must be driven by persons with a valid driver's license.

Two carts will be provided for beverages during play. **Beverage carts must be driven by adults age 21 or over with valid driver's licenses.**

Tournaments with less than six foursomes will be given consecutive tee times off Hole #1.

Tournaments with more than six foursomes will have a shotgun start backing up from Hole #1.

The course will be closed for tournaments with 60 or more players. For tournaments with 40 or less players, outside play will be allowed three hours after the tournament start time. If all teams in the tournament start on Hole #1 using tee times, outside play will be allowed one hour after the last tee time.

Call Pine Burr at 601-928-4911 at least three days before the tournament with an approximate number of players.

The Pine Burr Tournament Committee is available to provide assistance if requested.

After Tournament Clean Up

Porch and deck (if used): Cleaned.
 Garbage bagged and placed in dumpster at the northeast end of the parking lot.
 If moved, furniture placed back as it was before tournament.

Ballroom (if used): Tables and chairs cleaned and placed back in storage.
 Garbage bagged and placed in dumpster at the northeast end of the parking lot.
 Floor swept and mopped if needed.
 Clean spills as they occur.

The \$100 deposit will be applied to the tournament charges if the porch, deck, and ballroom (as applicable) are cleaned.
